• 7U (T-Ball)

- Maximum length of 30 inches
- Maximum barrel diameter of 2-5/8 inches
- Unlimited length/weight drop
- Bats with greater than 2-1/4in. barrel diameter must be marked "USABB" * or stamped with "BPF 1.15" **

• 9U (Tadpole)

- Maximum length of 30 inches
- Maximum barrel diameter of 2-5/8 inches
- Unlimited length/weight drop
- Bats with greater than 2-1/4in. barrel diameter must be marked "USABB" * or stamped with "BPF 1.15" **

• 11U (Mosquito)

- Maximum length of 32 inches
- Maximum barrel diameter of 2-5/8 inches
- Unlimited length/weight drop
- Bats with greater than 2-1/4in. barrel diameter must be marked "USABB" * or stamped with "BPF 1.15" **

• 13U (Pee Wee)

- Maximum length of 32 inches
- o Maximum barrel diameter of 2-3/4 inches
- Maximum length/weight drop of -10
- o Bats must be marked "USABB" * or stamped with "BPF 1.15" **

15U (Bantam) A/AA

- Maximum length of 42 inches
- Maximum barrel diameter of 2-3/4 inches
- Maximum length/weight drop of -10
- o Composite, aluminum or wood combination

- 15U (Bantam) AAA
 - Maximum length/weight drop of -10
 - o Wood, Bamboo or Wood Composite
- 18U (Midget) AA
 - Maximum length/weight drop of -3
 - o Marked "BBCOR"
- 18U (Midget) AAA/College Prep
 - Wood, Bamboo or Wood Composite

Wood, bamboo and wood composite bats are permitted in all divisions.

Wood composite bats include wood bats with fiberglass sheathing and wood barreled bats with composite handles.

Wood composite bats do not include any bat that has any metallic component.
